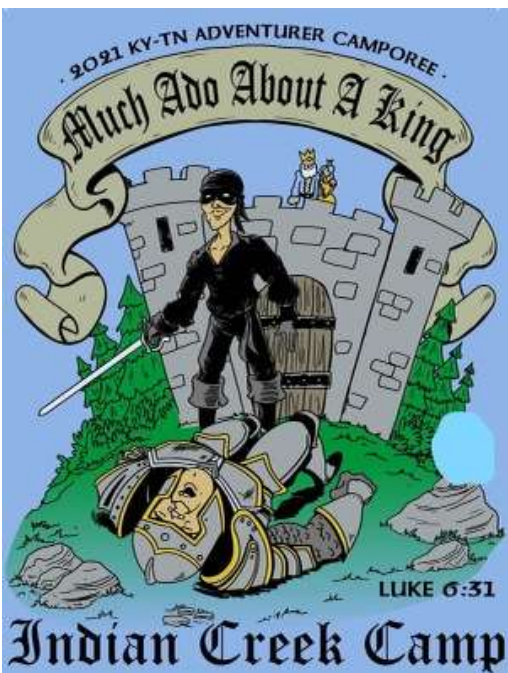

Leadership Conference 2021

Happy new year, Adventurers!

Hopefully your new Adventurer year is off and running without too many glitches. I know when I was a Director, some things (staffing, programming) may not have been *perfect*, but we were always blessed.

I want to thank you for the commitment that you've made to the young people of your church and maybe even the young people of your community. The time and energy that you invest into this ministry is sometimes described as a "sacrifice"—and it is. But the fruit of those many sacrifices is manifest for years—even many decades later—often unseen by you.

My biggest role is to provide leadership training for Adventurer staff throughout the year. That includes helping you fulfill Master Guide (MG) and Adventist Youth Ministries Training (AYMT) requirements. What's the difference between MG and AYMT? You could say that AYMT is for those that have completed their MG but that doesn't cover the entire story. Suffice it to say, a new leader should start with Basic Staff Training and that's what we'll offer starting sometime in January (in other words, after Camporee and holidays). Basic Staff Training covers all the ins-and-outs of how to run an Adventurer Club, the curriculum, yearly ceremonies, uniform, patches, etc. Basic Staff Training is part of MG and AYMT, so we'll be able to talk about both at that time.

These leadership workshops will be offered both on Zoom and live (probably at the Conference Office in Goodlettsville, TN). I will have a schedule made and posted on our website (www.kytnadventurers.com) at some point. Also, once a year in late August, KY-TN holds a Leadership Convention at Indian Creek Camp for Pathfinders and Adventurers where we will have 2 or 3 Adventurer tracks of workshops for attendees to choose from.

My other biggest role is this: Ask me anything! If you have any questions throughout the year, send it to me at adventurers.ky.tn@gmail.com. It'd also be great if you sent me pictures of cool things your Adventurers make and/or do. I'd love to see them! We can then share them with everyone in this newsletter.

How do our families register?

Visit us at: kytnadventurers.com and follow the prompts:

1. Click on *EVENTS*
2. Click on *2021 KY-TN ADVENTURER CAMPOREE*
3. Click on *COVID & CAMPOREE LETTER* and read.
4. Click on *INFORMATION & FAQ* and read.
5. Click on *REGISTRATION FORM*.

The registration form will need to be completed for EACH family member attending, this also includes babies. Once the form has been completed and submitted, you will be asked if you want to register another family member. Click on this prompt and it will take you back to the beginning of the registration form. (This needs to be done for each person.)

How does payment work?

Because of COVID, billing will be handled a little differently this year. Families will not need to pay in advance. After the camporee, we will send an itemized bill to church treasurers and club directors. It will be the responsibility of club directors to reconcile and collect for these accounts from the families.

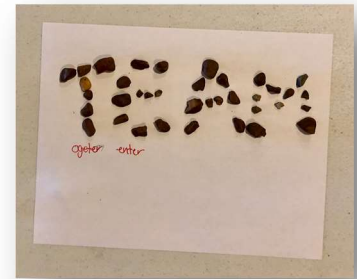
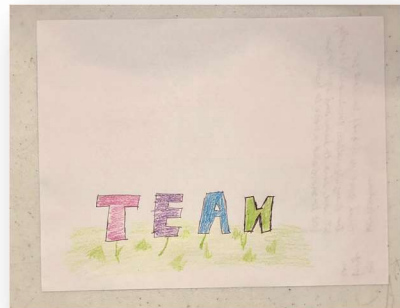
The club registrations need to be complete with the conference office by **October 31** to qualify to attend camporee as a club.

For any club not completely registered at this time, their families will have to pay the insurance premium to cover their family for the weekend. Premiums will probably run \$3-\$5 per person.

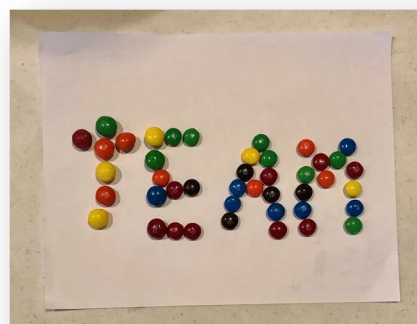
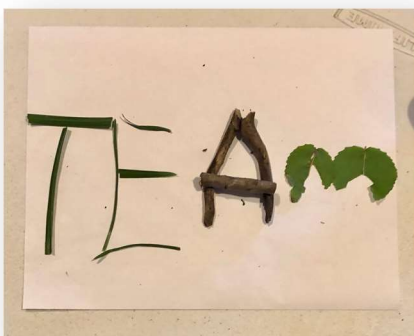
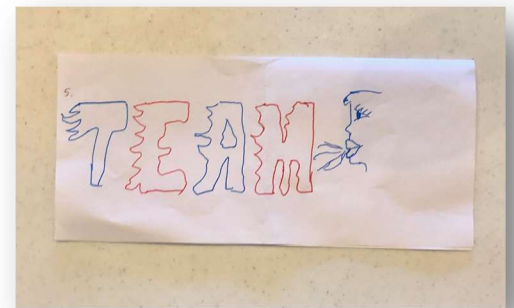
